# DAY OF AFRICA CHILD 16 JUNE 2022.



The Day of the African Child is celebrated every year on June 16th to commemorate the 16th June 1976 students uprising in Soweto, South Africa to protest poor quality education for the black students. Day of the African Child (DAC) was initiated in 1991 by the Organization of African Union (current AU).

In commemoration of the Day of the African Child, Leo Kesho Organization celebrated by donating various educational resources to support 20 children from families with low income in Mbeya district - Songwe region by providing learning materials such as pens, pencils, and exercise books.
